Perched above Eureka Valley, the home commands panoramic water views that stretch to the East Bay and San Mateo. The kitchen — handsomely fitted with horizontal rift-cut White Oak woodwork and paper-white Pental quartz counters and backsplash — offers a

Thermador refrigerator, dual ovens and a two-drawer dishwasher by Fisher & Paykel. Home chefs will appreciate the ample storage and peninsula counter for cookbooks, kitchen

electrics, or perfecting favorite recipes.

The lower three levels of the property offer amenities suited for today's lifestyles, including a nearly 500-square-foot guest

suite with all the amenities of a studio apartment.

Invite weekend guests or family in town for extended visits to enjoy the views from the living room, complete with a custom stone fireplace. An ensuite bath, laundry, and full kitchen with dishwasher and gas range complete this level.

A true two-car garage with side-by-side parking and gleaming coated floor awaits at street level.

Corona Heights, a beloved central-San Francisco hillside neighborhood known for its sweeping views, is home to Corona Heights Park, which includes a play space for canine friends and their owners.

The nearby Randall Museum focuses on the natural history, science, arts, and culture of the San Francisco Bay Area and offers programming for patrons of all ages.

The neighborhood is just blocks from restaurants and shops in both the Cole Valley and Castro Districts.
